



ABOUT THE HONOREES

Diane Abbey, Founder, Diane Abbey Law Center for Children and Families



Mrs. Abbey is the founder of the Diane Abbey Law Center for Children and Families at New York Law School. The Center was conceived with two goals in mind. The first was to prepare students for the practice of family law; this includes all aspects of law regarding family and children, their needs, and their rights. The second was to assist children and families in need in a variety of pro bono settings.

Mrs. Abbey worked as an English and English as a Second Language teacher at Theodore Roosevelt High School in the Bronx. After leaving teaching to raise two children of her own, Mrs. Abbey continued to work to better the lives of other children and families. As an educator for Planned Parenthood she spoke at schools, substance abuse centers, and after-school programs. She served on the Capital Campaign committee for New Alternatives for Children (NAC), an organization that provides a range of social services for disabled children and their families. At NAC she has served on the benefit committee and has been co-chair of several annual benefits. She was instrumental in establishing the volunteer corps for the agency. That program has expanded into tutoring, after-school and summer programs for the children and is now 300 volunteers strong.

Diane has served on numerous boards including that of the Brotherhood Synagogue, where she was actively involved in the campaign to totally renovate and restore the 1859 Friends Meeting House which now houses the Synagogue. She has served as a volunteer with the Brotherhood Synagogue Services, in which she was a provider in the Synagogue's shelter program for the homeless.

Mrs. Abbey is married to Arthur N. Abbey '59, who is Chair of the Board of Trustees of New York Law School. They have two children, Leslie and Jonathan, and Mrs. Abbey is the devoted grandmother of Graham and Hannah Dietz.

It is our pleasure to honor Diane Abbey for her tremendous commitment to children and families of New York City and her devotion to New York Law School.

Bruce A. Colbath '85, Partner, Weil, Gotshal & Manges LLP

Mr. Colbath is a partner at Weil, Gotshal & Manges LLP. A partner in the firm's litigation group, Mr. Colbath specializes in all aspects of antitrust law, advertising, and related consumer class-action litigation. He has had extensive experience in all phases of such litigation, including national coordination of cases, trial, and appellate work. Mr. Colbath has defended a number of major U.S. and foreign corporations in actions brought in federal and state courts, in a wide variety of industries including pharmaceuticals, automobile distribution, semiconductors, apparel, consumer financial services, and cosmetics. He has also represented and counseled clients on a wide variety of advertising issues, including several major state and federal investigations concerning advertising practices and consumer protection issues.

Mr. Colbath actively participates in various bar activities. He is active in the Antitrust Section of the American Bar Association, where he has held leadership positions in several committees and, most recently, served as an editor of one of the Section's leading treatises, *Consumer Protection Law Developments*, and drafted the chapter on private advertising litigation under the Lanham Act. Mr. Colbath is also a member of the Executive Committee of the Antitrust Section of the New York State Bar Association and is a member of the Consumer Affairs Committee of the Association of the Bar of the City of New York.

Mr. Colbath received an A.B. degree from Georgetown University. He obtained his J.D. from New York Law School, where he served as editor of the *Human Rights Law Journal*.

About the Honorees

Steven M. Klosk '87, President and CEO, Cambrex Corporation



Steven M. Klosk '87: *embracing innovation*, creating the future.

Mr. Klosk was appointed President and Chief Executive Officer and a member of the Board of Directors of Cambrex Corporation in May 2008. Cambrex is a NYSE listed life sciences company with revenues of approximately \$240 million, which provides products and services to support the development and manufacturing of small molecule therapeutics for the pharmaceutical industry. Cambrex employs approximately 850 employees, with manufacturing and R&D facilities in the USA, Estonia, Italy, Germany, and Sweden.

Prior to his appointment as CEO, Mr. Klosk served as Executive Vice President and Chief Operating Officer; President of the Biopharma and Pharma Business Units; and Executive Vice President, Administration since joining the company in 1992. In these roles, he participated in the acquisition of eight businesses with expertise in chemistry, biologics, and cell therapy, building the business to \$500 million in revenues. In 2007, Cambrex sold its biologics business for \$460 million and now focuses solely on chemistry and biocatalysis technology platforms.

Prior to joining Cambrex, Mr. Klosk served as Executive Vice President, Administration of The Genlyte Group, Inc., a global lighting manufacturer. He was part of the senior management team that led to the successful public spin-off of Genlyte and subsequent listing of the company on the NASDAQ stock exchange. Genlyte had over 2,000 employees in nine global operations.

Mr. Klosk graduated with a B.S. in Industrial and Labor Relations from Cornell University in 1979. In 2009, he was named one of the top 30 alumni in the class of 1979 by his Cornell University peers. He serves on the Cornell University Biomedical Engineering Advisory Board and has presented to students in the Biomedical Engineering Ph.D. program and addressed a class in the Cornell Entrepreneurship and Life Sciences program. He earned a J.D. from New York Law School's Evening Division in 1987. He served as a staff editor of the *Law Review*. Mr. Klosk has presented to New York Law School students in the alumni spotlight programs.

In addition to his role on the Cambrex Board of Directors, Mr. Klosk serves on the St. Joseph's Hospital Foundation Board and is a member of the Board of Directors of NPS, a privately held packaging company.

Mr. Klosk has been married to his wife, Rena Fox Klosk, whom he met at Cornell University, for 30 years. They have three children: Joshua, Melissa, and Julia, who are 24, 20, and 17 years old, respectively.

About the Diane Abbey Law Center for Children and Families

The Diane Abbey Law Center exists to ensure that children and the families who care for them receive the legal assistance they need to remain safe and secure, and to thrive.

Abbey Center students work in placements throughout New York City helping children and families in need of legal services. Founded in 2009, the Center offers a comprehensive curriculum aimed at creating excellent practitioners able to represent children and families in all aspects of family law. In just one year, students have volunteered in Family Court Help Centers in the Bronx, Manhattan, Brooklyn, and Queens, assisting pro se claimants with everything from filing petitions to finding their way to the right courtroom. They have interned with the Center for Court Innovation, working with the Youth and Community Courts. They have worked with victims of domestic violence, and couples in need of uncontested divorces. They have helped families suffering health care crises.

In addition, this academic year, the Center will host a summit on children of incarcerated parents, a policy conference on adoption, an annual lecture and contest on ways law can help protect the health of children and families, "Expert Lunches" on topics ranging from systemic improvements in foster care to international adoption, as well as a major conference on juvenile justice reform in New York.

Currently, Abbey Center Associates also participate in:

- creating and writing a Center blog aimed at raising awareness of important issues in the field, and fostering public conversation
- working with New York Law School's acclaimed Safe Passage Immigration Project to obtain legal immigrant status for unaccompanied immigrant children
- assisting with all Center programs, including hosting symposia and lectures (e.g., the Pegalis-Erickson Lecture Series), bringing practitioners together in a variety of conversations aimed at improving the lives of families and children
- participating, via the New York Law School Elder Law Clinic, as court evaluators in guardianship matters
- assisting unrepresented families and children by staffing tables in the family courts of four boroughs under the aegis of Legal Information for Families Today (LIFT), as well as a volunteer program with the Office of Court Administration

The Abbey Center is already a powerful voice for the children and families of New York City.
