To all who shall see these Presents, Greeting:

*Know Ye; That reposing special trust and confidence in the Wisdom, Uprightness, and Learning of Roger J. Miner, of New York, I have nominated, and by and with the advice and consent of the Senate, do appoint him United States Circuit Judge for the Second Circuit and do authorize and empower him to execute and fulfil the duties of that Office according to the Constitution and Laws of the said United States, and to Have and to Hold the said Office, with all the powers, privileges and emoluments to the same of right appertaining, unto Him, the said Roger J. Miner during his good behavior.*

*In testimony whereof, I have caused these letters to be made patent and the seal of the Department of Justice to be hereunto affixed. Done at, the City of Washington this twenty-second day of July, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred eighty-five, and of the Independence of the United States of America the two hundred tenth.*

SECURITY OUTLINE FOR THE INVESTITURE  
OF THE HONORABLE ROGER J. MINER, U.S.  
COURT OF APPEALS, JUDGE, FOR THE  
SECOND CIRCUIT

PRIMARY PERIMETER SECURITY: PARKING LOT & LOBBY

- A. THE STATE PARKING LOT WILL BE UTILIZED AND MONITORED BY ONE F.P.O.
- B. THE P.O.C.H. LOBBY SOUTHWEST ENTRANCE WILL BE UTILIZED, AND MONITORED BY ONE F.P.O. WITH A GUEST LIST.
- C. THE P.O.C.H. LOBBY NORTHWEST ENTRANCE WILL BE UTILIZED, AND MONITORED BY ONE D.U.S.M. WITH A DIGNITARY GUEST LIST, AND A PORTABLE RADIO.
- D. WHEN THE LOBBY NORTHWEST DIGNITARY GUEST LIST IS COMPLETED THE DOORS WILL BE LOCKED.
- E. THE P.O.C.H. LOBBY WILL BE MONITORED BY A CONTRACT SECURITY GUARD.

SECONDARY PERIMETER SECURITY: FOURTH FLOOR

- A. THE SOUTH ENTRANCE WILL BE MANNED BY TWO C.S.O. PERSONNEL WITH A MAGNETOMETER.
- B. A GUEST CHECK LIST WILL BE MONITORED BY THE ABOVE MENTIONED C.S.O. PERSONNEL.
- C. THE NORTH ENTRANCE WILL BE MANNED WITH ONE D.U.S.M. WHO WILL BE IN RADIO CONTACT WITH THE D.U.S.M. ON THE LOBBY NORTHWEST ENTRANCE. THIS D.U.S.M. WILL ALSO HAVE A DIGNITARY GUEST LIST.
- D. WHEN THE NORTH ENTRANCE DIGNITARY GUEST LIST IS COMPLETED THE DOORS WILL BE LOCKED.

**INTERNAL SECURITY:**

- A. U.S.M.S. PERSONNEL WILL BE ROVING AND MINGLING WITH GUESTS ATTENDING.

**FIRE EMERGENCY PLAN:**

- A. UTILIZE ALL EXITS.
- B. THE F.P.O. WILL NOTIFY THE ALBANY FIRE DEPT.
- C. THE TWO C.S.O. PERSONNEL WILL BE THE LAST PERSONS TO LEAVE THE FOURTH FLOOR, AFTER A QUICK SEARCH FOR ANY REMAINING PEOPLE ON THE FLOOR.
- D. THE C.S.O. PERSONNEL WILL CLOSE THE FIRE DOORS.
- E. THE U.S.M.S. AND F.P.O. PERSONNEL WILL SECURE ALL GUESTS IN A SAFE LOCATION AWAY FROM THE BUILDING.
- F. THE ALBANY FIRE DEPT. WILL TAKE CONTROL OF THE BUILDING AS NEEDED.

**EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE PLAN:**

- A. THE NEAREST AVAILABLE SECURITY PERSON TO THE VICTIM WILL NOTIFY THE F.P.O. AND C.S.O. PERSONNEL.
- B. THE F.P.O. PERSONNEL WILL NOTIFY E.M.S. TO RESPOND TO THE SOUTHWEST LOBBY ENTRANCE.
- C. THE CONTRACT SECURITY GUARD WILL CAPTURE AN ELEVATOR AND WAIT FOR THE E.M.S. PERSONNEL ON BOTH LOBBY AND FOURTH FLOORS.

**HOSTAGE EMERGENCY PLAN:**

- THE U.S.M.S. WILL CONTROL ALL ACTIVITIES.
