Maynard, Jr., by police officers: Lt. Walter J. Stone, Commanding Officer, 6th Detective Squad; Detective Edward O'Brien, Shield No. 35, Manhattan South Homicide Squad; Detective Albert J. Hanast, Shield No. 251, 6th Detective Squad; Ptl. George Gardella, Shield No. 20196, 7th Precinct; Detective Robert Plansker, Shield No. 213, 6th Squad; Detective Joseph G. Cordes, Shield No. 1980, Ballistics Section; Ptl. John Dowd, Shield No. 2854, 7th Precinct; Ptl. Patrick O'Connor, Shield No. 9270; or any other officers, including:
