2 area firms told to pay back wages

Two Albany car rental firms have been ordered by U.S. District Court Judge Roger J. Miner to repay \$31,305 in back wages to 105 company employees for overtime and record-keeping pay violations.

The two companies are Budget Rent-A-Car of Albany and NALA Industries Inc., which does business under the name of Budget Rent-A-Car of Syracuse Inc., according to the U.S. Department of Labor.

The Albany area office of the Labor Department's Wage and Hour Division, which made the investigation, will notify the workers eligible for back pay, the Labor Department announced.

The division is responsible for supervising the \$3.35-an-hour minimum wage and overtime pay laws.

A spokesman at Budget Rent-A-Car said president Allan Sloane was out of town and unavailable for comment.
