That he is a Detective in the New York City Police Department

That Gisselle Nicole is a material and necessary witness
 on behalf of the People herein. That deponent is informed and verily believes that the said

Gisselle Nicole will not appear to
 testify when required from the fact that Gisselle Nicole is a native of Germany,

she is presently a prostitute, she is a German alien who is wanted for
 questioning by the United States Immigration Authorities concerning
 irregularities in her residence herein the United States and has fled from
 legal charges of the New York Telephone Company and various other debts she
 has occurred here in the United States. She is a former girl friend of
 the defendant and was the one who advanced money to the defendant so he could
 flee to Europe. She has been the object of a search by police authorities
 for at least nine months and left her prior residence when she learned that
 police were coming and she admits that she has been trying to avoid
 apprehension by the police. She has no known residence, occupation or
 employment at the present time.

Wherefore deponent prays that the said
