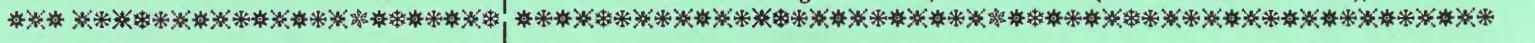

facts you should know about

Group Study Space at NYLS



As finals approach, study groups move into high gear. The Mendik Library has only five Group Study Rooms, and sometimes that's just not enough to accommodate all the groups who want to study together. During these congested times, we ask that you keep in mind the following:

- **The most important rule is courtesy!** You have no right to occupy a Group Study Room by yourself, or with other single studiers. There are *many* other places in NYLS where you can study quietly by yourself. Don't try to "reserve" the room by leaving your personal belongings in it. And, if you're in a group, don't monopolize the room! Give it up after a few hours so that another group can use it. Take careful note of the rules that are posted on the door, and be sure to follow them.
- **Your study group has the right to "bump" individual users from a Group Study Room.** Your group should do this by politely asking the single users to surrender the room. Your group may enlist the Reference Librarian on duty to help resolve a conflict, but remember that librarians aren't police! The best way to avoid conflicts is through courteous and considerate behavior.
- **If the Group Study Rooms are full, try a classroom.** When classes are over, NYLS classrooms become available as group study spaces. If none of the Group Study Rooms in the Library are available, ask the Security Guards in 47 Worth St. to unlock an empty classroom for your group.
