On August 2, campus buzzed with law students from across the northeast and more than 60 high-profile employers.

For the ninth year in a row, NYLS hosted an annual job fair for the <u>Northeast Region</u> (https://www.neblsa.com/) of the National Black Law Students Association (NEBLSA). The event draws international law firms, top government agencies, courts, and renowned public interest employers. Employers and students meet one-on-one after a matching process coordinated by NEBLSA.

NYLS has a strong presence on NEBLSA's leadership team, and NYLS students played a key role in organizing the event. For NEBLSA, **Maraya Aboly-Brown 2L** is Regional Job Fair Coordinator, **Alea Roberts 4L Evening** is Director of Corporate Relations, **Allan Louis 3L** is Chief of Staff, **Jasmine Bridges 3L** is Director of Social Action, and **Renee Akperov 3L** is Convention Coordinator.

In addition, **Aisha Joseph**, NYLS's Director of Academic and Career Advising and a Deputy Diversity Officer at the School, was involved in planning the event. NEBLSA has 1,000 active members who hail from dozens of law schools in eight states: Connecticut, Maine, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, Rhode Island, and Vermont.
