1- The undersigned, Lt Stone 6th Sqd and Det O'Brien MSHS have questioned the above witness on numerous occasions since date of crime.

2- On April 3rd 1967 at about 4:15AM Seaman Crist was walking south on 6th Av in the vicinity of W 4th St. He was approached by a male negro who made an indecent proposal to him. (Male negro later identified and interviewed as James Barnhardt-106 Thompson St Apt #3) An argument ensued and seaman Crist chased Barnhardt across 6th Ave at 4th St and down 6th Ave into W 3rd St. He overtook Barnhardt F/O 135 W 3rd St (Purple Onion) where argument continued. At this time Ptl John Dowd 20854 7th Pct - separated the two and escorted Barnhardt to MacDougal St and observed him walk toward Bleecker St. Seaman Crist was approached at this time by a male negro and male white and the male negro said "What happened"

Seaman Crist started to answer but for no apparent reason another argument ensued. Crist and the male negro were about to exchange blows when the male white told the male negro "Come on man, lets go". As the two males were leaving Sgt Krell had parked his car and came over and asked Crist "What's the matter mate". After a short conversation Sgt Krell invited Crist to ride in his car. They started north on 6th ave and they overtook the two males who had continued on 6th ave to W 4th St and now going east on 4th St. Sgt Krell stopped his car alongside of the 2 males. He then got out of the car and walked to rear of same and approached the 2 males. The male negro at this time was holding a sawed off shotgun and as Sgt Krell continued to approach him the male negro fired one shot. Sgt Krell fell to the street and the two males fled.

Seaman Crist the in a state of shock got back into the auto and drove off to seek aid. He eventually returned with Ptl. Dowd.
