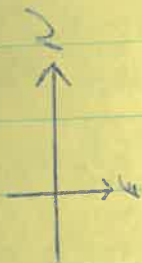

Sometime Between 2 + 4 pm Barnhardt
walked into the White Mark Deli on 6th Ave. As he
was walking ~~in~~ Christ walked ~~in~~ ^{out} with a can of
beer. When Barnhardt walked out Christ had finished
the beer. Barnhardt walked south on the west side
of 6th Ave; when he reached the door of St. Joseph's
parish house he saw Christ on the doorway. Christ
approached ~~him~~ Barnhardt & "stomped" his feet
threateningly in front of him. Barnhardt had not
said anything to Christ. Barnhardt kept walking when
he reached the front of St. Joseph's church Christ started
chasing him and ~~him~~ Barnhardt started running.
Barnhardt ran south on 6th Ave. and at some place
crossed 6th Ave. He turned east on 3rd Street where
he tripped and fell in front of the "Purple Onion"
Christ caught up with Barnhardt at that point. He
swung twice at Barnhardt, but missed both times.

At McDougal street Christ turned left towards
w 4th st. and Barnhardt walked south towards
Slaker street. He turned east on Bluebe towards
Thompson street and walked home. He saw
no men coming to his assistance, nor did he
notice anyone paying particular attention to
what had happened. He doesn't know ~~where~~
where Christ went after he (Christ) turned north
on McDougal street.

Barnhardt had wanted to press charges against
Christ, but the cops talked him out of it by telling
him that since Christ never actually landed a
blow the court would throw the case out. Christ's
explanation to the cop ~~at the~~ for the assault was
that a man had slashed his (Christ's) wrist
earlier and Barnhardt looked like the man.
Christ had one of his wrists bandaged that night.

The next morning the cops asked Barnhardt
to come down to the police station. They had
Christ in custody. I'll see you all.

Bernhardt's impression of Christ was that
