WILLIAM A. MAYNARD, being duly sworn, deposes and  
says:

1. I am the defendant in the above-captioned case  
and make this affidavit in support of a motion to provide my  
counsel with a daily copy of the minutes.

2. I have now been incarcerated, either in Germany  
where I was arrested on this charge, or in the New York City pri-  
son at 125 White Street, New York, New York, for almost three  
years. I have earned no income during this period and have  
exhausted all of my assets in defending myself in the prior trial  
in this matter.

3. I have no knowledge whatsoever of any fund  
presently in existence which would in any way be available to  
support my defense.

4. It is a matter of court record that I have been  
declared indigent by the Court for purposes of assigning counsel  
to me and providing counsel with a daily transcript. I know of  
no circumstances which would change my condition of indigency.
