1-The assigned with Lt Stone 6th Sqd and Det Edward O'Brien interviewed the above mentioned person in the 6th Sqd office

2- Denis Morris states that at about 4:30 AM 4/3/67 he was on Third St walking toward 6th Ave (on the uptown side of street) when he observed a cop escorting a male negro toward MacDugal St. He then observed a sailor who was walking toward 6th Ave, the sailor was loud and raising Cain. A negro and a white boy came along and said something to the sailor. Then there was an exchange of words and the negro fellow took his jacket off (Bark jacket). The white boy led the negro fellow away (North on 6th Ave towards W 4th St) at this point a car pulled up and a marine got out and joined the sailor. After discussion between sailor and marine they entered car and drove in same direction as the negro and white boy, they overtook ~~themselves~~ the negro boy and white boy at

West 4th St, about 50 feet into 4th St at which time the marine stopped the car got out and walked to rear of the car and came toward the male negro. The negro was holding a sawed off shotgun and fired as the marine continued to approach him. The marine then grabbed his face and fell backward into the street. The perpetrators then fled to 6th Ave and north on 6th Ave. After the marine was shot the sailor got out of car and looked at him, he then got back into the car and drove away and a little bit later came back with a cop.

This witness observed the perpetrators looking back toward 3rd St prior to sailor and marine following same and the witness sensed there was going to be a fight so therefore he followed them to 4th St.
