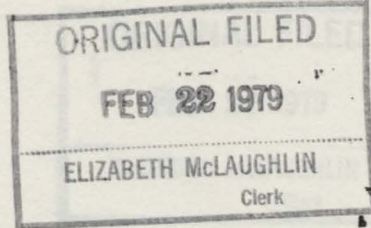

The cause is remanded to the law division for the interrogation of jurors pursuant to R. 1:16-1, with the following directions: The interrogation is to be conducted in camera and in the presence of the prosecutor and defense counsel. The interrogation is to be conducted by Judge Bruno L. Leopizzi. The jurors to be interrogated by Judge Leopizzi in the first instance are Adamo, Alario, Armellino and Demetriades. Should Judge Leopizzi determine that additional jurors should be interrogated, he is free to exercise his discretion and summon such additional jurors before him for questioning as he shall determine. The interrogations herein directed are to be conducted within a period of 30 days from the date of this order. Any motions to be made by counsel arising out of the interrogations should be made promptly after the conclusion of the interrogations.

This remand is limited to the issues contained in this order and shall not interfere with the progress of the substantive appeal presently pending before this court which has tentatively been placed on the calendar for argument before us on May 30, 1979 at 10:00 a.m. in the Court House, Hackensack, New Jersey.
