(Summary)

There was ev of discharged from bore of the single shot shotgun. Inspection at 5:15 pm on April 6 w/ Det. Hanast present in 1967.

Barrel was 10 and 3/4 inches

Overall length of gun was 19 inches.

Evidence of discharge in the bore means that as a result of a cartridge or shell being discharged, there was a deposit of burned powder, unburned powder granules on the surface of the inside of the bore.

Serial # of gun 07715.

Gun was 12 guage Hopkins and Allen TB single shot cutdown shotgun,

Gun was given to ballistics person at 5:15 April 6, 1967.

Wouldnt tell where it was found.

Wouldnt tell whether the plastic casing People's 64 for identification would or could have been fired from this gun

Wouldnt tell who owned it.

Wouldnt tell if there was a check for fingerprints.

Gun can be broken down into 3 parts. One could be as short as 11 or 12 inchws.

Three parts together could be as short as 16 or 18 inches and still be operable.

And if gun is shorter than 16 to 18 inches you might not have enuf area to hold on to and might injure yourself in discharging the gun.
