Overall length of gun was 19 inches.

Serial # of gun 07715.

There was ev of discharged from bore of the signle shot shotgun. Inspection at 5:15 pm on April 6 w/ Det. Hanast present in 1967.
Barrel was 10 and 3/4 inches

Evidence of discharge in the bore means that as a result of a cartridge or shell being discharged, there was a deposit of burned powder, unburned powder granules on the surface of the inisde of the bore.
