

Dear Ms. Novendstern:

This is in response to your request under the Freedom of Information Act for the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission file, Sperandio v. Sumitomo Shoji America, Inc. Your request is denied pursuant to Exemption 3 of the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. §552(b)(3). Exemption 3 enables EEOC to withhold matters that are prohibited from disclosure by statute. See Parker v. EEOC, 534 F.2d 977 (D.C. Cir. 1976). §706(b) of Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended, makes it unlawful for the Commission to make public any charges, and §709(e) makes it unlawful for the Commission to make public any information obtained pursuant to its authority under this section prior to the institution of any proceeding under Title VII involving such information.

If you wish to appeal the denial of your request, you may do so within 30 days after receipt of this letter by writing to Chair, Equal Employment Opportunity Commission, 2401 "E" Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20506. You must attach this letter to your appeal letter. Your appeal would be governed by the provisions of 29 C.F.R. §1610.11.
