This letter confirms our telephone conversation of October 4, 1988 with regard to how we are proceeding under the Special Master reference provisions of the decree.

We have agreed that the Special Master was properly appointed pursuant to our joint stipulation which was so ordered by Magistrate Dolinger on May 26, 1987. We have further agreed that it will not be necessary for the Clerk of the Court to furnish the Special Master with a copy of the order of reference, as the parties furnished Dean Glickstein with this document as well as with a copy of the consent decree.

We have further agreed that specific disputes which arise under the decree may be submitted directly to the Special Master by either of the parties. Thereafter, the Special Master will exercise his powers pursuant to Rule 53 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and the terms of the consent decree.

I would be most appreciative if you would confirm our agreements in this regard.
