MEMORANDUM OF RJM

I vote to accept the report of the Subcommittee on Commemorative Events and to approve the Midnight Judges and Patents projects. I assume that the remaining exhibit proposals will be submitted for specific approval when more details are available.

While it is most desirable that all our displays be mounted in a manner that will enable them to travel, it seems to me that a contribution of \$10,000 for that purpose in connection with the Midnight Judges exhibit may be more than the Bicentennial Committee should commit to one project. Although we do not yet know what resources will be available to us, perhaps it might be a good idea at this point to fix a "cap" for each project.
