2054 - MARY QUINN - for def - direct

Q: And you seeing Mr. M on Sixth Ave and 38th Street that morning, was that by a prior arrangement?

A: It was. I had a court appt that morning, April 3, and I was very anxious to get in touch with Mr. M because we had retained his lawyer, Mr. Siegel, and I had never been in court before and I was very worried about it. I called him at 66th Street, to my knowledge, there was no answer. I called up my mother's. He was there. I spoke ~~xxxx~~ with him. The reason I didn't go to my mother that Sunday was because he was there. I was not living with him. I didn't want to see him and I wouldn't be seeing him except I had this court appt which petrified me.

Q: So, you had a telephone conversation with Mr. Maynard and Mr. Maynard was at your mother's home; is that correct?

A: Yes.

Q: That Sunday?

A: Yes.

2055 - MARY QUINN - for deft - direct

A: Since court convenes at 9:30, I'm very sure we planned to meet on that corner at 9:00. I remember waiting there; maybe I was five minutes early.

So, I got there say 5 to 9, and I was waiting and waiting. I would say he arrived anywhere between 9:15 and 9:25.

2057 - MARY QUINN - for deft - direct

Maynard dropped off Michael and met Mary about a block up
cause she didnt want anyone to know.

Flew down FDR drive.

Arrived in court around 9:40 - 9:45, and judge arleady
on bench, part 2B.

MARY QUINN - 2062 - for deft - cross

Q: Is there any possibility whatsoever that you were in the apartment of your mother with the defendant, thru the night of April 2, 1967, into April 3, 1967?

A: No.

Q: There is no possibility of that fact, is that correct?

A: That's correct.

2064 - MARY QUINN - for def - cross

COURT: On April the second. You know that on April second you did call him.

A: At my mother's house.

COURT: At your mother's house.

A: And we determined thru prior arrangement --

COURT Did you speak to him?

A: Yes.

COURT: At what time was that, on April the second?

A: ~~At~~ What time? It was probably later - late afternoon.

COURT: The afternoon of April the second.

A: Yes.

COURT: All right. Before dinner?

A: I dont know.

Q: Well, it is possible that you could have contacted him concerning the court case prior to April 2, 1967, say Saturday or the Friday?

A: I would have been very certain to call him the day before to make sure that he was there.

Q: You have any independent recollection, or is that just an assumption that you are making?

A: No, that is something that I remember doing.

2069 - MARY QUINN - for def - cross

Prior inconsistent statements from page 1027 prior hearing

Q: ... Do you have a different recollection today than you did a year ago?

A: No. I was asked if I contacted Mr. Maynard before April the third. I did contact him. There is no mention where about my court case. I was referring to just general contacts. Mr. Gallina was asking me did you contact him. Yes, I contacted him. We were working on a boutique.
