Defendant was convicted, after trial, of manslaughter in the first degree, and the Appellate Division, First Judicial Department, affirmed the conviction.

Defendant's post-judgment motion to vacate the judgment or to set aside the sentence pursuant to sections 440.10 and 440.20 of the Criminal Procedure Law is granted to the extent of setting the matter down for a hearing on April 23, 1973, at Part 30 of this court. The issues raised by the moving papers and opposing papers require a further amplification in order for the court to be best able to decide this matter.

The application to afford the defendant a polygraph examination is hereby denied with leave to renew before the hearing court.

The clerk of the court is directed to enter the necessary order to provide for the appearance of the defendant.
