 - Constitution "One person, one vote" doctrine
 - Census taken every 10 years Take into account change in population and demographics
 - VRA 1965
 - ensure plan maintain protections of certain racial and language minorities protected under federal voting rights act, no diluting
 - Analysis to do that
 - Charter reflects that criterion as well
 - Also have population deviation rule under newly-passed state law
 - Difference in population of each difference the difference between most populous and least populous shall not exceed 5%
 - City charter also lays out the criteria and the order that it must be applied
 - Keep neighborhoods and communities of interest intact
 - Compact shapes
 - Limit crossover districts covering more than one borough
 - Contiguous districts natural boundaries
