I spoke to Elizabeth Quinn by telephone on October 6, 1970. She tells me that when the police first came out to her house (Hanast, O'Brien and Stone) they told her for the first time that Mary and Maynard were married. It shook her up.

She says thereafter she attempted to reconstruct the weekends and was convinced that Maynard had slept overnight the first weekend after Easter, which would have been April 2nd. She remained convinced until Gallina pounded away at her at the interviews in the District Attorney's office prior to trial, and then finally decided that Maynard was there either the weekend of the 2nd or the following weekend; and she says now she's not sure.

Elizabeth can testify that Maynard is a good dresser, etc., that even his casual clothes were extremely smart - leather. That he did not own a windbreaker or pea jacket, and would not be seen wearing the same.

She can also testify that while he looked young (25) he could not be mistaken for a man 18-20.

*Follow up interview by DPM:
Mrs. Quinn was asked whether she remembered having discussions with her family about Harvey's flooding a week after Easter Sunday - she remembered and stated that she was convinced that Michael and Maynard were at her home the Sunday following Easter Sunday.
She also recalled that Maynard had slept on her new velvet couch that weekend and Michael had slept in his old bed.*
