At your last meeting, you requested that I determine what events will occur in Philadelphia on or about September 17, 1987. First off, I should correct a statement I made at that time: The Judicial Conference of the United States will meet the following week, on September 21st and after; however, all circuit chief judges have been invited to attend the festivities in Philadelphia on September 17, and I understand that most have accepted.

The Third Circuit will be holding its circuit judicial conference September 17, and it naturally will focus on the Constitutional bicentennial. Justice Stevens, Dean Black, and many others will participate in many ways. I will have a draft program in a few weeks, when it is available. At the same time, President Reagan will have a large production in Philadelphia, whose details are not known to me; I take it that the national Bicentennial Commission is in some degree involved.
