Hruska, President, will present the Sixth Annual Historical Lecture on Tuesday, April 22, 1986, at 4:30 P.M. in Courtroom 110, United States Courthouse, Foley Square, Manhattan. This year, the lecture will be delivered on the history of the Western District of New York by its Chief Judge, the Honorable John T. Curtin.

The second part of the program, co-sponsored by the Second Circuit Exhibits Subcommittee, co-chaired by Judge Lawrence W. Pierce and John D.
