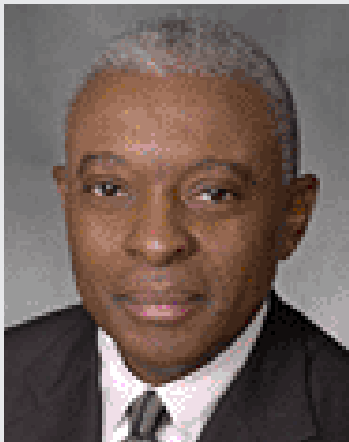

Errol Taylor will discuss how recent developments and changes in the law impact pharmaceutical patent protection.

Mr. Taylor is a partner in the New York office of Milbank, Tweed, Hadley & McCloy and leads the firm's biopharma patent litigation practice. He also chairs Milbank's Diversity Committee.

Mr. Taylor focuses mainly on representing research pharmaceutical, biotechnology, and chemical companies in patent litigation and related counseling. He has particular expertise in cases involving generic drug approvals and the Hatch-Waxman Act. Mr. Taylor has served as lead trial counsel in numerous multiparty, multinational cases involving some of the world's most prescribed medicines.

Mr. Taylor has given lectures in the areas of pharmaceutical litigation, interference procedure, damages, and injunctions to various legal professional associations, including the American Bar Association, American Intellectual Property Law Association, Federal Circuit Bar Association, Pharmaceutical Research Manufacturers Association, National Bar Association, New York Intellectual Property Law Association, and Association of the Bar for the City of New York.
